Tonight, I want to do a scripture study on four verses of John 15 to relate thoughts on how Jesus is the vine, the life giver, the lifeblood of the believer and how we can receive a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit when we are in love with Him.

Jesus the True Vine by Tom Singer

To get ready for a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit let us talk about how Jesus is the vine and we are the branches from John 15.

“I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser.” (15:1)

Jesus is the true, loyal, and intimate Son of the Father.

“Every branch of mine that does bear fruit he prunes that it may bear more fruit” (15:2)

We must believe that when we are pruned it is for us to bear more fruit!

“You are already made clean by the word which I have spoken to you” (15:3)

When we humble ourselves and receive the word, we are cleansed.

“Abide in me and I in you. As a branch cannot bear fruit by itself, neither can you, unless you abide in me, for apart from me you can do nothing.” (15:4)

If we want to bear fruit, we must really enter into intimate union with Jesus.

“I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in me, and I in him, he it is who bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.” (15:5)

The Holy Spirit comes upon a person who desires and hungers for an abiding union with the Lord.

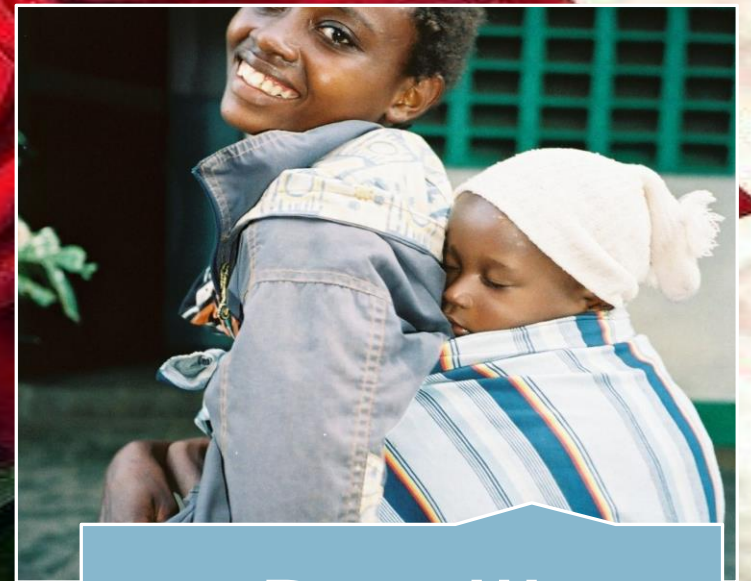
