On **Wednesday, March 11, St. Bartholomew Parish in Bethesda** will once again host **Fr. Ubald Rugirangoga**, a survivor of the Rwandan Genocide and author of *"Forgiveness Makes You Free"* as he celebrates a **Mass with Healing Prayers at 7 pm.**

During the 1994 genocide, Fr. Ubald lost over 80 members of his family and over 45,000 of his parishioners were exterminated. He escaped through the Congo on foot in the middle of the night. When he left Rwanda at that time, he made a promise to his Bishop that he would return to bring healing to his people.

Fr. Ubald has an amazing healing gift and his focus is on healing, forgiveness, and evangelization wherever he goes. The Government of Rwanda seeks him out for advice on forgiveness and reconciliation as the country continues to rebuild after the devastation of the genocide. Fr. Ubald preaches healing in Rwanda, the Congo, and Burundi where it is not uncommon for crowds from 10,000 - 80,000 to attend. He has traveled all over Europe, the Holy Land, and various African countries. Fr. Ubald made his first trip to the United States in 2009 at the request of Immaculé Ilibagiza, another genocide survivor and author of *Left To Tell*, who currently resides in the U.S. You may learn more about Fr.
