The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) in paragraph 2084
“God’s first call and just demand is that man accept him and
worship him.”

“When we say ‘God’ we confess a constant, unchangeable being,
always the same, faithful and just, without any evil.” (CCC, 2086)

“For if man exists, it is because God created him through love, and through love continues to hold him in existence”. (Gaudium et Spes, 19)

All of creation is waiting for the chosen children of God to proclaim: “Jesus is the Lord!”

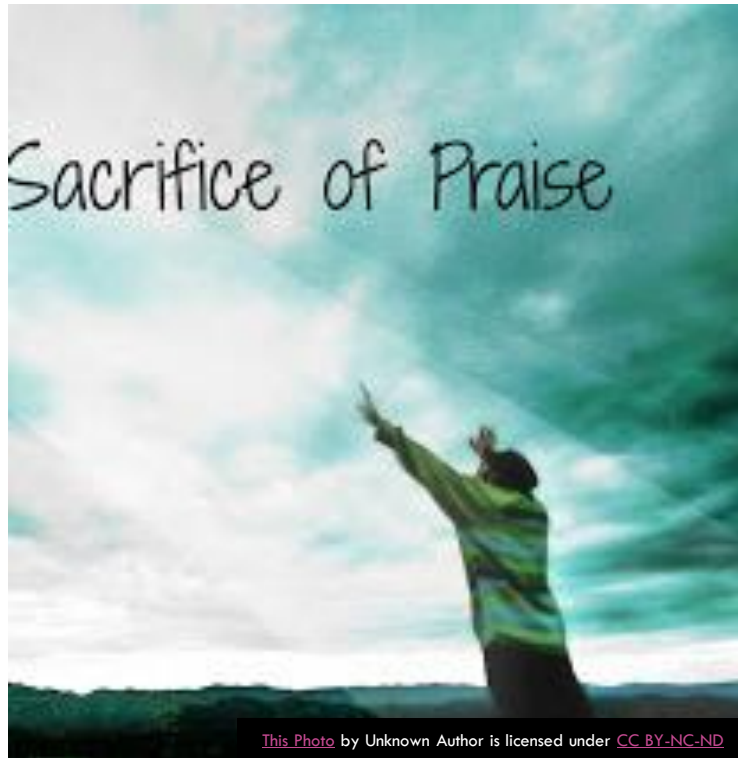
And we are his sons and daughters who are called to constantly assert this.

Praising in the Midst of Suffering

Father Cantalamessa in his CHARIS exhortation he gave in preparation for Pentecost says: *we praise God because we are sure that He will be able to draw good out of that very evil, for us and for the world. We praise Him precisely because we are convinced that everything works out for the good of those who love God, and above all, of those whom God loves.*

He recounts that Paul and Silas were praising God in prison (Acts 16) not to be released from prison, but to thank God for the life they had received and the honor they had in proclaiming Jesus and Gospel.

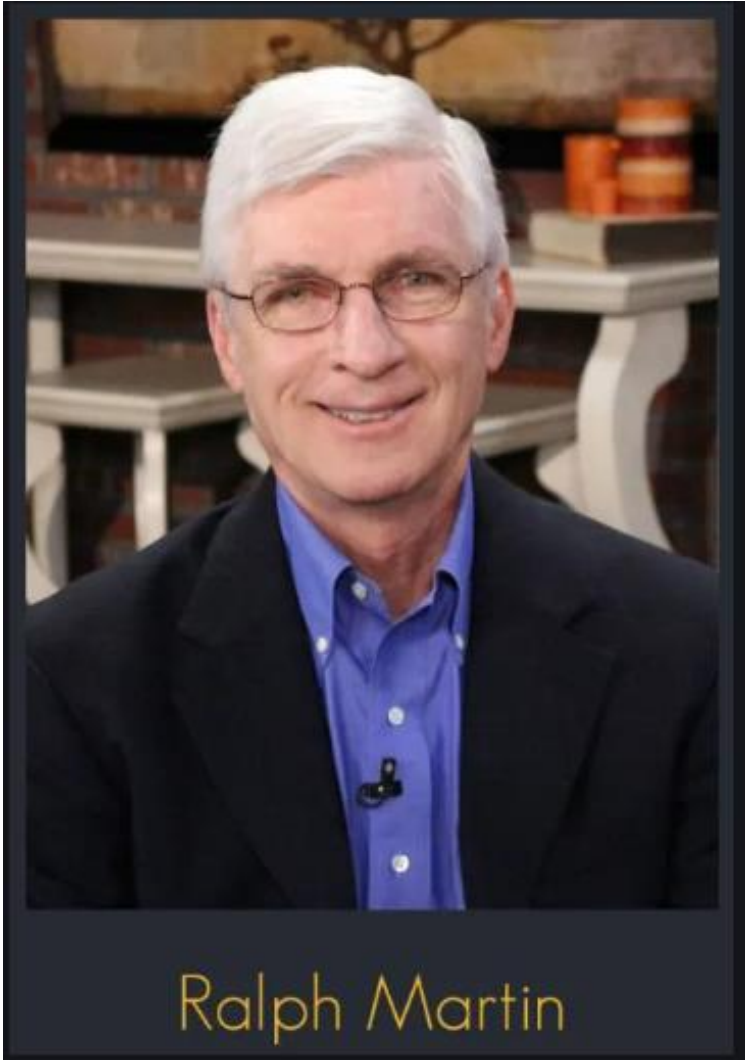
Praising in the Midst of Suffering
